INFORMATION PROVIDED BY ART. 13 OF LEGISLATIVE DECREE 30/06/2003 no. 196

Pursuant to art. 13 of Legislative Decree 30/06/2003 no. 196 "Code for personal data protection"
The following information is provided.

The data may be used for different purposes, including, but not limited to, the following examples:

- conference organisation and management
- fulfilment of fiscal and accounting requirements
- activity planning
- internal control services
- customer management
- supplier management
- marketing
- opinion research and statistic analysis

Data will be collected by the interested party as well as by other parties.

Data collection may occur by telephone, electronically or also in public places or areas open to the public, from lists, public records and documents.

The data may be provided on a national, community, extra-community level to the following subjects:

- partners and offices affiliated with Interprofessional Network Spa;
- subsidiary, associated and controlling companies and companies with which Interprofessional Network Spa collaborates;
- professional and consultancy offices, consultants and self-employed professionals, also in an associated manner;
- professional networks.

Rights of the interested person.

Reference is made to art. 7 of Leg. Decree 196/2003, which regulates the rights of the interested person:

Section 7 (Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights)

1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exists, regardless if the data has already been recorded, and communication of such data in an intelligible form.

2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed of the following:

- a) the source of the personal data;
- b) the purposes and methods of the processing;
- c) the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out electronically;
- d) the data identifying the data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2); e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may become aware of the data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.

3. A data subject shall have the right to the following:

updating, correcting or, when interested, integrating the data;

deleting, anonymization or blocking of data that has been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which it has been collected or subsequently processed;

certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves to be impossible or involves a considerably disproportionate effort in comparison with the right that is to be protected.

4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,

on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though it is relevant to the purpose of the collection;

to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or otherwise for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.

The data controller is Interprofessional Network Spa headquartered in Verona, Via Righi, 6.

If the data subject wants to have the data concerning him and that is in our possession deleted, he may do so by responding to the email that accompanies this information, clearly indicating the word Cancella - Delete. The data will be removed by us immediately
